We emphasize hands-on, real life care in all aspects of the program. All of our faculty members are currently in practice, an important cornerstone of our program, giving you indispensable exposure to the kind of work you'll step into after graduation. Our program emphasizes health equity and addressing social determinants of health both in the community and health care settings. Students can interact with patients speaking languages other than English and gain experience with culturally diverse populations. We offer access to unique clinical opportunities including addiction medicine, homeless health, and centers that provide evidence-based care across the gender spectrum. Your coursework will include four core courses (graduate research and sciences), one elective, and nine theory/clinical courses. The clinical courses include classroom work, lab sessions, and clinical preceptorships focused on physical assessment and pathophysiology, health maintenance, and the management of common acute and chronic health problems.
