SCHOOL LEADERSHIP, CERTIFICATION

The Principal Certification-Only Track is for public/charter school administrators and educators who already hold a Master's degree and are seeking eligibility for Principal Certification. Over its five courses, this track provides a 360-hour internship, focused class topics, and practitioner assignments relevant to the public/charter school environment. ^{1, 2}
