The Music Minor will consist of **any six courses in Music**. The Music Department offers classes in many areas and at many levels that are broadly organized around the sub-disciplines of Musicology, Ethnomusicology, Music Theory, Composition, and Performance. While students may simply follow their interests intuitively through six or more music classes, they may also design a minor in order to pursue a concentrated interest, such as electronic composition, the music of Africa, the history of opera, or an interdisciplinary approach to performance, just to name a few of many possibilities.
